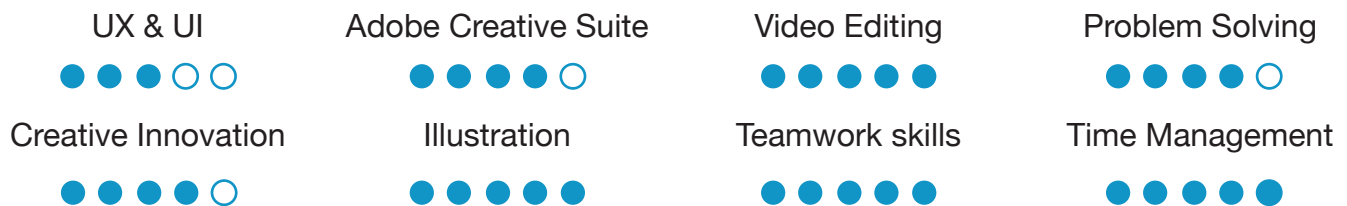

Short Films:

LIFEBOOKS (2016-2023) Perspective & Reality was the thirty-minute short film I created during the first semester of my master's program. This film is focused on a full visual recap of my Lifebooks from when I first started the project in 2016 to the beginning of my master's program in 2023. In addition, I created short animations of the interviewees' shoes driven by the phrase "Walk a day in someone else's shoes." The film's overall theme was to create a relatable, introspective presentation, showcasing my visual and auditory perspective while relating to other's insight on what the words "reality" and "perspective" meant to them.

How To Sit, Was my first solo short film. This three minute film took a simple everyday action and gave it an overcomplicated set of instructions for the viewer to follow step-by-step.

So far I have about 20 pages of various short stories, poems, and life lessons. I have adapted daily thoughts and lists integrated with my artwork to describe and work out my creative process.
